

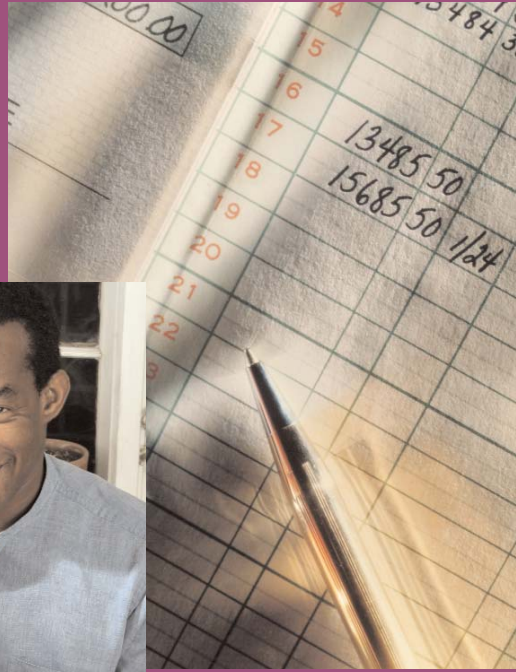

## Did you know that it's possible to become a CPA in Vermont without a degree?

Completion of courses in the professional accounting program fulfills the academic requirements to sit for the CPA examination in Vermont. There are additional requirements-such as work experience-that also determine eligibility to be licensed as a CPA in Vermont. ### Sequence Overview

#### The Accounting Sequence includes the following courses:

- + BSAD 17 Business Law
- + BSAD 18 Business Law
- BSAD 161 Intermediate Accounting (prerequisite course is BSAD 60)
- BSAD 162 Intermediate Accounting (prerequisite course is BSAD 161)
- BSAD 164 Introduction to Federal Taxation (prerequisite course is BSAD 60 or BSAD 65)
- BSAD 168 Cost Accounting (prerequisite course is BSAD 61)
- BSAD 266 Advanced Accounting (prerequisite course is BSAD 162)
- BSAD 267 Auditing (prerequisite course is BSAD 162)



#### Class Schedule & Location

+ These courses are available online and during Summer Session as well as in the evening and during Summer University on UVM's main campus. The other courses are available during the day with registration via instructor permission. Several day courses are offered each term; go to [registrar.uvm.edu](http://registrar.uvm.edu) to view.
