Position Description:

The non-credit online Accelerated Integrative Health and Wellness Coaching Certificate at the University of Vermont (UVM) is growing, and we are looking for a dynamic Motivational Interviewing Instructor to join our team to create a cohesive and supportive curriculum. UVM's program is accredited by the NBHWC and is a collaboration between UVM's Division of Professional and Continuing Education and the College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

As a member of our instructional team, you will develop and instruct four weeks of advanced Motivational Interviewing/Coaching Psychology classes online. Direct instructional responsibilities will occur January 24 - February 14, 2023, with development of course content in the Summer and Fall of 2022.

You will create asynchronous online curriculum content and prepare and facilitate synchronous online learning sessions via Zoom. In your instructional responsibilities, you will also assess student proficiency.

Required Qualifications:

Motivational Interviewing Expertise

- Familiarity with science and evidence of coaching psychology practices (self-determination theory, positive psychology, social cognitive theory, etc.)
- Master's Degree or above in a health-related field
- Active clinical practice
- Willing to be part of a dynamic teaching team in a new online program
- Strong computer skills

Position requires course preparation time, proficiency assessment, and daily communication with students and faculty as needed over email or Zoom while the course is active. Availability to teach remotely on Tuesday evenings from 6:00-8:30pm Eastern Time is required for the following dates in the Spring of 2023: January 24, January 31, February 7, and February 14.

Preferred Qualifications:

- NBC-HWC certification (with minimum 200 hours of practice)
- Teaching experience
- Virtual or online instruction experience
